Covid-19 Funding Update

Covid-19 Catch-up Premium

The government has announced £1 billion of funding to support children and young people to catch up. This includes a one-off universal £650 million catch-up premium for the 2020 to 2021 academic year to ensure that schools have the support they need to help all pupils make up for lost teaching time.

Universal Catch-Up Premium

The £650 million of universal catch-up premium funding will be available for all state-funded mainstream and special schools, and alternative provision. It will cover:

- primary, secondary and all through local authority-maintained schools, academies and free schools
- local authority-maintained special schools
- special academies and free schools
- special schools not maintained by a local authority
- pupil referral units
- alternative provision (AP) academies and free schools
- local authority-maintained hospital schools and academies
- independent special schools

Catch Up Premium Allocations

Mainstream Schools will be allocated £80 per pupil from Reception to Year 11. Special Schools and Pupil Referral Units (PRU) will receive £240 per place. The initial estimates are based on January 2020 pupil census data and published place numbers and indicate the grant allocation for Bury's schools and academies is as follows:

National Tutoring Programme

Alongside the universal catch-up premium, the government are launching a £350 million National Tutoring Programme to provide additional, targeted support for those children and young people who need the most help. Tutoring will begin from the second half of the autumn term and ramp up through spring term 2020. A portal will open in due course for schools to register their interest to participate.

Schools will be able to use their catch-up premium to contribute to the subsidised cost of the programme.

Covid-19 Exceptional Costs Reimbursement Scheme

We are still awaiting some claims to be agreed and reimbursements made to schools, where they claimed in the 'other' category and/or breached the threshold limit. The DfE aim to have all outstanding claims amounts validated and reimbursed by the end of October. Full reimbursements may not be made where the DfE have rejected any items included in 'other'.

To date there are 6,500 schools/academies in the national cohort awaiting reimbursement.

It is expected that the DfE will provide reasons to individual schools where any amounts are not reimbursed – if any schools find themselves in this position please let Steven Goodwin know the DfE explanation as this will be useful to advise other schools as part of the guidance to be circulated in due course for the second claims window.

The second claims window will be launched after the outstanding claims from the first claims are settled. There is no specific guidance or timelines as yet, however you do need to be aware that this will not be a new opportunity to claim up to another refreshed threshold. This second window is to help schools review what they have claimed during the lockdown window from March to July and identify any expenditure that may not have been included in the first claim.

There are no expectations that the criteria for claims will be varied to the original specifications, and schools will be able to claim for Premises, Cleaning and Free School Meals, plus other costs incurred above 'normal' activity within the dates specified (which at the moment only cover March to July).

The above means that schools have the opportunity to claim up to their original thresholds set, you can actually claim above but this will be subject to DfE scrutiny and, as mentioned earlier, it will be useful to hear from schools that have had any 'other' amounts rejected by the DfE so we can share this for consideration where required.

From the first claims window there was a total of £1.985m allocated to thresholds across Burys' Maintained schools, and only £805k was claimed, equals £1.175m potentially not claimed. Five schools did not submit a claim. Three schools claimed in excess of their thresholds.

For Academies there was £710k set within thresholds – the LA does not have access to see how many Academies claimed and at what level.

Therefore if your threshold was £25,000 and your first claim was for £17,000 you have at least £8,000 to claim in the second window. Any amount claimed above £8,000 will be subject to close DfE scrutiny.

Guidance will be issued to all of schools as soon as it is released by the DfE. Regular reminders will be sent out together with any useful advice to ensure no schools miss their opportunity to claim.

Unfortunately Maintained Nursery Schools (MNS) remain out of scope and will not be added to the second claims window.
