

# A Walk in Chesham Woods

The walk, which is marked by white arrows (highlighted in orange on the map), takes you through four of Chesham's six small woods, though there are other paths you may wish to explore. It can be reached from Clarence Park (where there is a car park), from Chesham Road, or from Swallow Drive.

The tree species most commonly found are sycamore, beech, oak, ash and lime, with the three ornamental woods also containing chestnut, rhododendron and privet. The hedges are mainly hawthorn. There were formerly a number of elms in the woods. These succumbed to Dutch Elm disease and have now been felled.
