## WESTHOUGHTON.

WEST HOUGHTON is a township, and populous village, in the parish of Deane, 5 miles west-south-west from Bolton. The Church of St. Bartholomew is in the early Gothic style, with tower at the east end; the entire cost of the building has been defrayed by John Seddon, Esq. Richard Haydock, Esq., has given a peal of eight bells, which have been cast by Messrs. Taylor and Co., of Loughborough. The architects of the above church are Messrs. Cunliffe and Freeman, of Bolton. This is the third church on the same site. The church lately pulled down was built in 1731, on the site of an old chapel, which was erected as appears from documents, about 1509. The register dates from 1732. The living is a perpetual curacy, annual value £149, with residence, and 28 statute acres of glebe, in the gift of the vicar of Deane. A fine east window by Clayton and Bell, of London, has been placed in the chancel by the parishioners, "in grateful remembrance of

the generosity of John Seddon, at whose sole cost the church has been re-built." The Rev Kinton Jacques, M.A., of Brasenose College, Oxford, is the vicar. A new ecclesiastical district has been formed out of part of this township, and comprises the whole of the township of Lostock. The Church of St. John is situate at Wingates, and was built in 1859. The living is of the annual value of £70, with residence, in the gift of the vicar of Deane. The Rev. George S. Hodges, B.A., of Jesus College, Cambridge, is the present vicar. There are chapels for Independents, Society of Friends, Primitive Methodists, &c. A fair is held on the 1st of May and 12th of October. The population in 1861 was 5,156; the acreage is 4,460; the rateable value in March, 1866, was £18,635, March, 1868, £20,185, and in March, 1870, £22,006. The Earl of Ellesmere, Le Gendre N. Starkie, Esq., Wm. Ford Hulton, Esq., Col. Wilbraham, and Benjamin Gaskell, Esq., are chief landowners.
