- provide evidence that you are on a low income or are experiencing financial hardship

Where did a Wellbeing course take Pinky?

After having surgery for a brain tumour, I unfortunately had to leave my job as a Practice Manager in a clinic. It was an extremely long recovery and the aftermath was challenging. Not only did I struggle physically, but mentally and emotionally too. I was unable to drive and I became quite lonely, socially isolated and lost my confidence, including losing friends.

I decided I wanted to write a book on my experiences of having a brain tumour, so in May 2024 I enrolled on a local creative writing course. When the course finished, a group broke off and formed their own class, but it really wasn't for me.

I found out online that Bury Adult Learning Service offered a creative writing course, the bonus being it was for wellbeing too. I was quite nervous and anxious on my first day, but as soon as I walked into the class, I was welcomed warmly by my tutor. She seemed to take away my fears and anxiety almost immediately with her friendly, approachable manner. She set tasks that were thought provoking and helped me find my voice and built my confidence.

I wrote in class a story called 'The Diary' and my tutor encouraged me to submit my stories to magazines. I entered a competition with a magazine that was asking for "A New Year's Resolution That Had Changed Your Life." I received a reply saying it was going to be published! Since January this year, I have had two Star Letters published and various other shorter submissions in a couple of magazines.

Another piece I wrote was published in an online magazine and I have read out five stories on North Manchester FM radio. I have entered a couple of writing competitions and I also joined a writer's circle.

I can honestly say, attending the Creative Writing for Wellbeing course has helped in my recovery from what was one of the most difficult times in my life. Bury Adult Learning Service has been so supportive and gave me a feeling of community. I don't feel I would be where I am now if it wasn't for them. I can't thank my tutor and all the staff enough!

This year, I was nominated for Learner of the Year and to my surprise I won!

My message to anyone who's feeling lonely and not knowing what to do with themselves, whatever situation you might find yourself in, enrolling on an adult learning course is a great way of getting out of the house and meeting new people. It's just taking that first step. You've got nothing to lose but a lot to gain!

Family Learning

Are you a parent or carer looking to get more involved in your children's education?

Our Family Learning team delivers courses in schools, Family Hubs and various community settings across the borough. These courses support parents and carers to build their own confidence and skills, which enables them to help their children reach their full potential, both at home and at

school, building positive relationships and stronger community links wherever we can have an impact.

In addition to supporting their children, there is an emphasis on empowering parents to enable them to be effective educators at home as a springboard from which to become sufficiently confident and skilled to explore opportunities that could lead them into further avenues of work or study themselves. Classes can involve the children working alongside their parents with the class teacher and the support of the Family Learning tutor (with a focus on a specific school year group and subject area), or are parent-only,

where parents work together with the adult tutor to improve their own skills and knowledge.

Fees And Discounts

How much will it cost?

Bury Adult Learning Service receives funding from the Greater Manchester Combined Authority (GMCA) in order to provide learning to adults. Learners who have a post code outside of the Greater Manchester area will be funded by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA). The fees quoted in this guide represent a contribution to the overall cost of the course, other than those that begin with the course code "LP". These courses are self-financing, therefore learners do not receive any funding from the GMCA or ESFA towards the cost of their course.

Some of our provision is fully funded by the GMCA/ESFA, for example English, maths and some IT. Depending on your circumstances you may also qualify for a free course in other subjects, or a reduced rate. Please bring proof of any benefits at the time of enrolment.

The fees for each course are listed in this guide.

Courses with qualifications

You may be entitled to a fully funded qualification course depending on your circumstances, or previous qualifications obtained. Please enquire at the centre for more information.

Qualification courses only

We can fully fund learners that are employed/self-employed if they earn under £25,000. The learner must provide evidence of gross annual wage, which could be a wage slip, or universal credit statement, which must be within 3 months of their start date. A contract of employment showing monthly or annual gross pay can also be provided.

Courses without qualifications

We offer a discount for courses that are not qualification based. If you currently claim a state benefit, please enquire at the centre to find out if you are entitled to a reduced fee. You will need to provide evidence at the time of enrolment in order to qualify.

Refunds

It is not the policy of Bury Adult Learning Service to automatically refund fees when a change of circumstance prevents or discourages a learner from continuing with a particular class.

A full refund will be paid if Bury Adult Learning Service cancels the course within the first 2 sessions. This will be refunded on a pro-rata basis thereafter.

Except where it states specifically, we cannot pay a refund of fees due to circumstances beyond our control, e.g. war, terrorist activity, industrial dispute, bad weather, fire and flood.

In exceptional circumstances (at the discretion of Management), other refunds may be given. These requests must be made within 2 weeks of your last attendance for a refund to be considered.

Refunds will not be given for exam fees already paid to the awarding organisation.

Additional charges

Some courses involve costs other than published fees. These are detailed on the course information sheet for each course. Course information sheets can be requested from the Bury Adult Learning Centre or downloaded from www.bury.gov.uk/ adultlearning
