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In-centre Survey Methodology Note

Survey Dates

There are four centres to be surveyed (Bury, Ramsbottom, Prestwich and Radcliffe), each on two separate days. One of these days is considered to be a busier shopping day, one a quieter day to ensure a good spread of people using the centre. In centres where markets are held (Bury and Radcliffe) one of these days is a market day. For Ramsbottom, a survey is being carried out on a Sunday to ensure the tourist attraction of the town is being taken into account.

The dates of surveys for each town centre are copied below.

Daily Schedule

The centres will be surveyed between 09.30 and 13.30 with each of the four surveyors meeting in the centre to allocate survey positions at 09.20. The meeting point in each centre are as follows:

- Bury to the south of point 4 on the survey location map outside Argos;
- Prestwich next to point 2 on the survey location map adjacent to the public art in the Longfield Centre central square;
- Ramsbottom next to point 1 on the survey location map outside the entrance to Morrisons; and,
- Radcliffe next to point 2 adjacent to the bandstand in the central square.

Council Surveyors will work in two shifts on each day, one from 09.30 until 13.00 and one from 13.00 until 16.30. Drivers Jonas Deloitte surveyors will work all day from 09.30 until 16.30 with an hour lunch break. One surveyor should take this break between 12.00 and 13.00 and one from 13.00 to 14.00. The timings of lunch can be decided by the individual surveyors on each day.

Survey Locations

There are four surveyors for each town centre and each has an approximate location to conduct their surveying within that town centre. Proposed locations are indicated on the maps appended to this note. The surveyor does not have to stay in exactly this spot although should avoid straying significantly far so as to avoid clusters of surveyors in particular areas of the centre. Each surveyor should collect at least 25 responses of people who are intending to make a purchase on the day of the interview, in total giving at least 50 responses per centre and a total of 200 across all surveyors. The survey locations for each centre are:

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Prestwich

- 1. Southern entrance to the Longfield Centre circuit outside Cancer Research UK store;
- 2. Square adjacent to the Longfield Centre northern entrance;
- 3. Bury New Road adjacent to Marks and Spencer Simply Food; and,
- 4. The western side of Bury New Road just to the north of the bus stop adjacent to Michael Herwald and Co.

Bury

- 1. The Rock main square (the surveyor in this location needs to report to The Rock security office prior to beginning the surveys);
- 2. Outside the former Marks and Spencer unit within the Mill Gate Centre;
- 3. The square between the Mill Gate Centre and the market outside Katsouris; and,
- 4. Haymarket Street adjacent to the Argos store.

Ramsbottom

- 1. Outside the entrance to Morrisons;
- 2. Bridge Street outside Ramsbottom Sweet Shop;
- 3. Market Place adjacent to the water feature; and,
- 4. On the western side of Bolton Street outside Fisherwoods Carpets.

Radcliffe

- 1. Adjacent to the pedestrian crossing and subway on Pilkington Way;
- 2. In the central square adjacent to the bandstand;
- 3. Dale Street south-eastern side adjacent to Limelight Amusements; and,
- 4. The area around the Dunelm Mill store (including the car park and adjacent streets).

The above survey locations are not fixed (as indicated by the rough zones on the maps) and surveyors should feel free to move around in the vicinity of the points indicated in search of higher response rates. However, surveyors should avoid clustering to avoid shoppers being asked questions more than once in close succession.

Survey Questions

The questions are indicated below:

- 1. What is your main purpose for visiting CENTRE [Bury/Ramsbottom/Prestwich/Radcliffe] today?
- 2. Have you or are you intending to make a purchase in CENTRE today?
- 3. Which shops have you visited or do you intend to visit in CENTRE today?
- 4. How did you travel to CENTRE today?
- 5. How often do you normally visit CENTRE?
- 6. Where else do you go to do your shopping most often?
- 7. What is your main reason for visiting CENTRE what is your favourite thing about it?
- 8. If you could improve one thing about CENTRE, what would it be?

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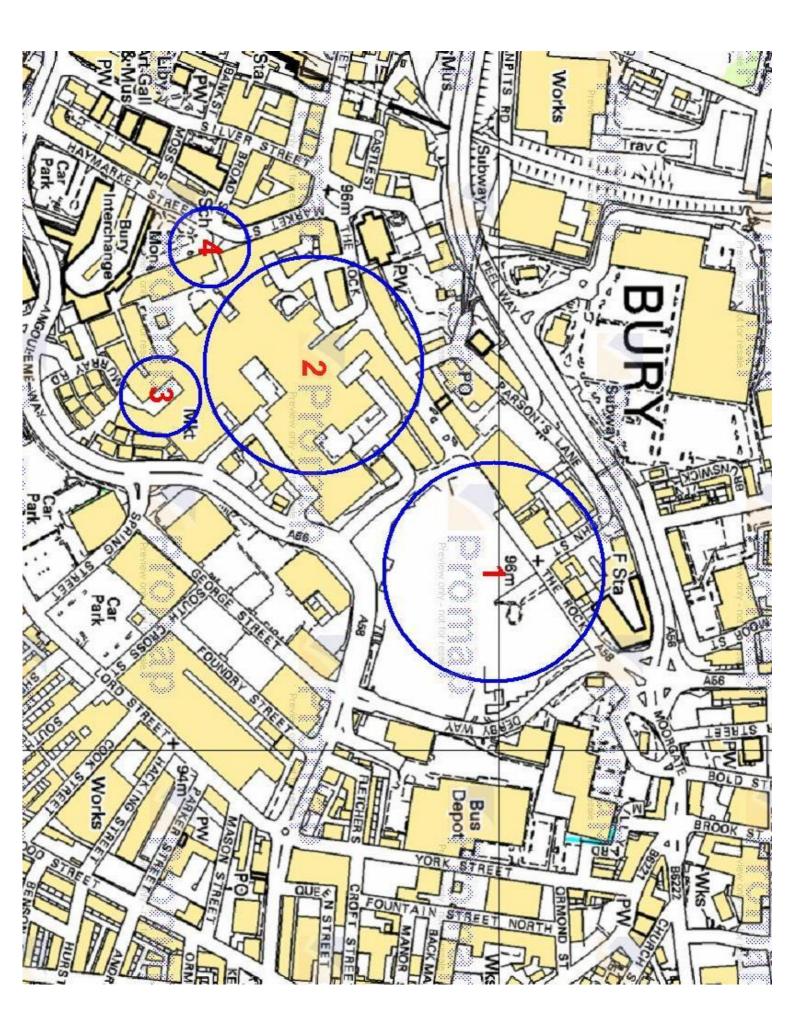


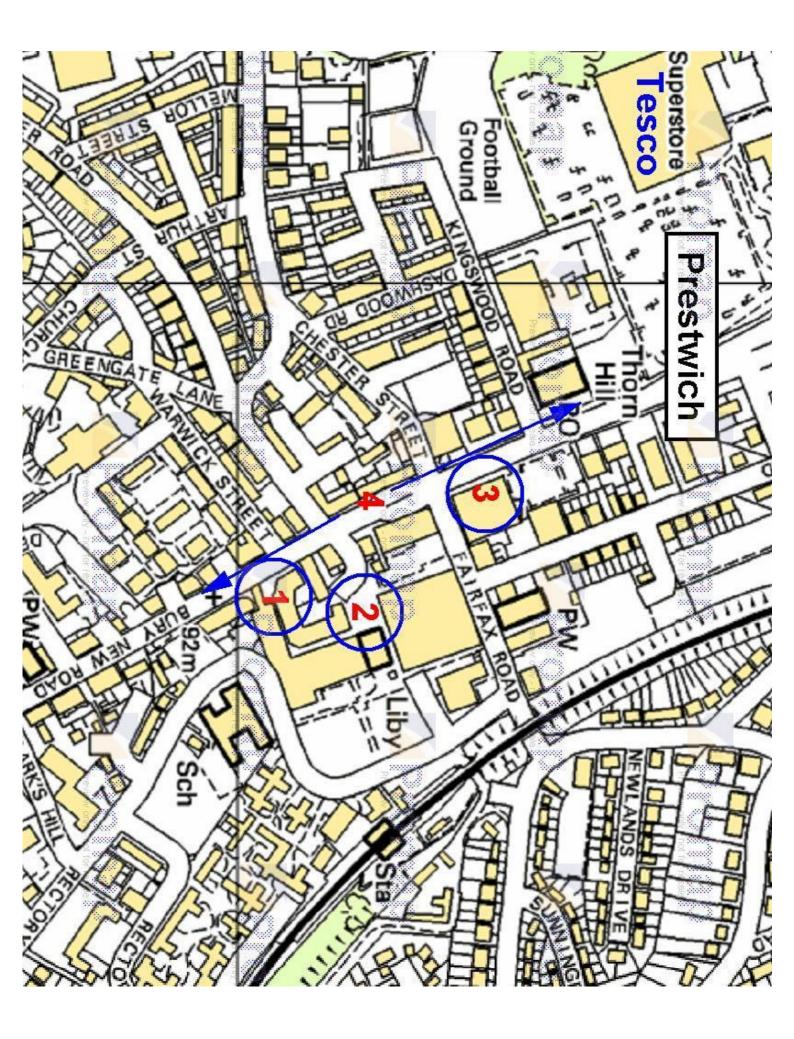

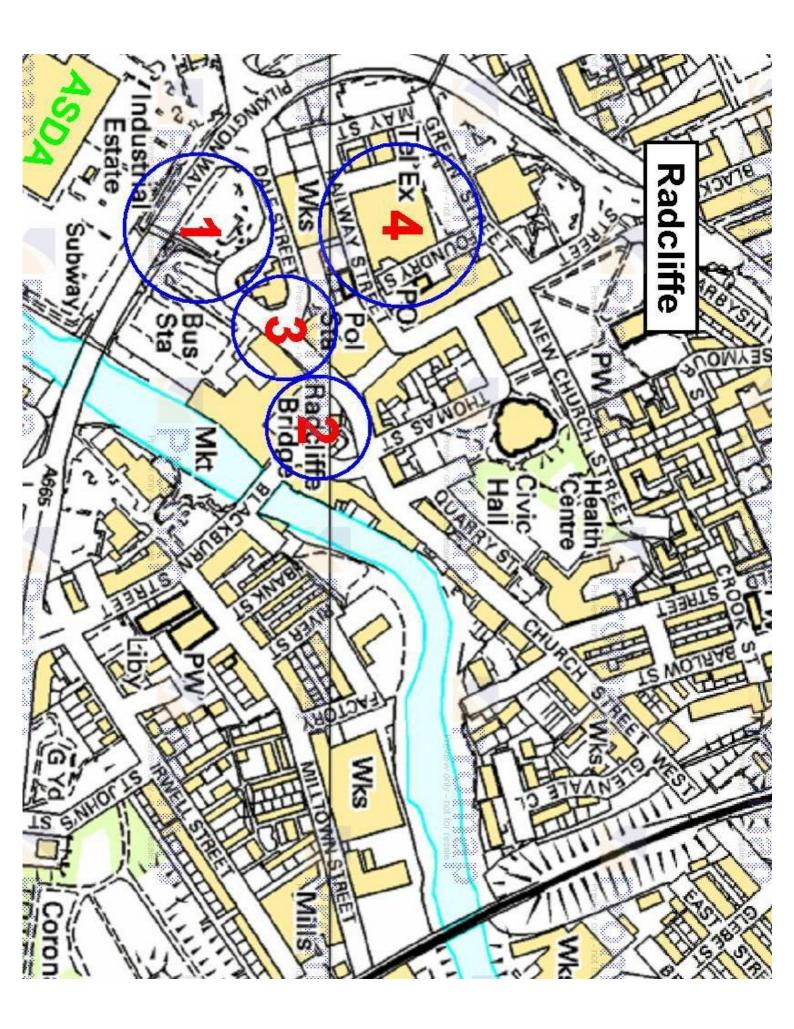
An example survey instruction sheet including the above questions and potential responses is attached to this note.

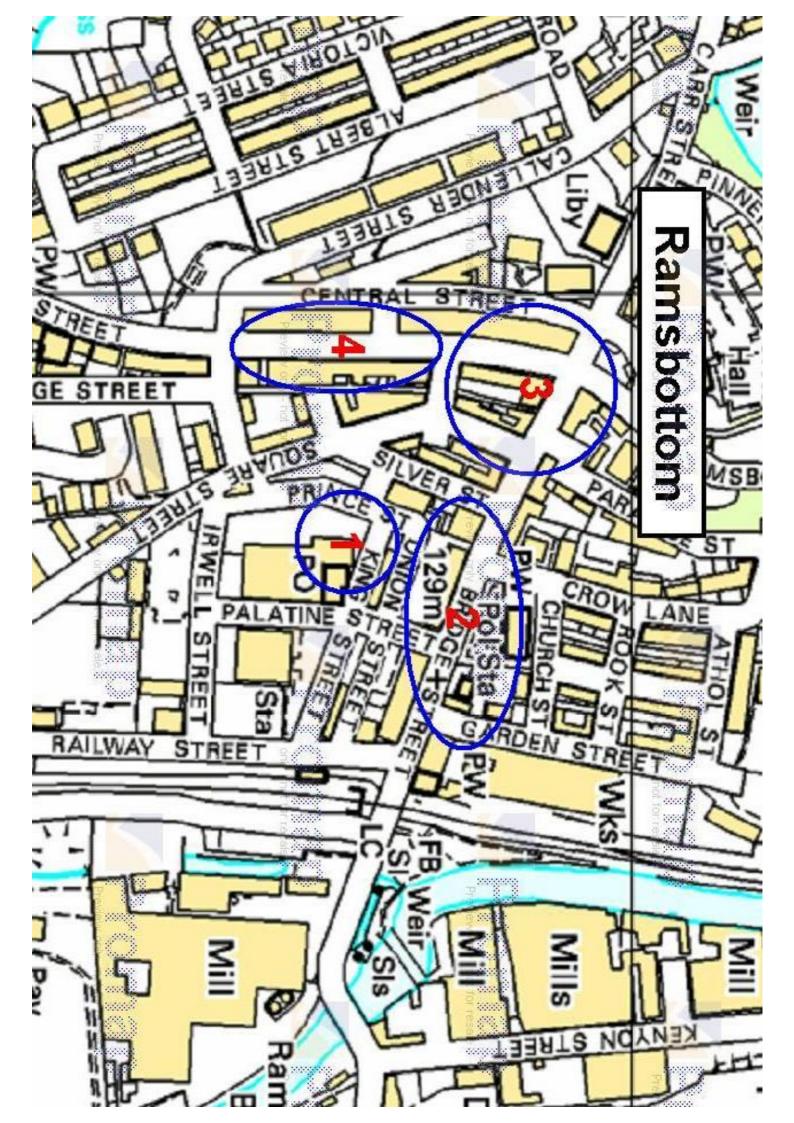
Demographic Split

A representative spread of respondents should be sought ensuring examples from different age groups and gender are surveyed. However, it is not necessary to aim for an equal number of responses from different demographics as the centre may be patronised more heavily by particular groups so a random selection of survey respondents should reflect the overall users of the centre. If a respondent is shopping with a group of people, only one respondent in one group may take part in the survey – the birthday rule should be adopted. This would be the person with the 'next birthday'
