On Sunday 26th June we travelled down to London on the train.





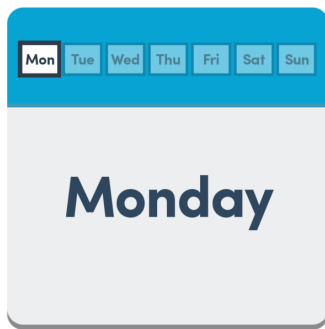


We enjoyed an open top bus tour.

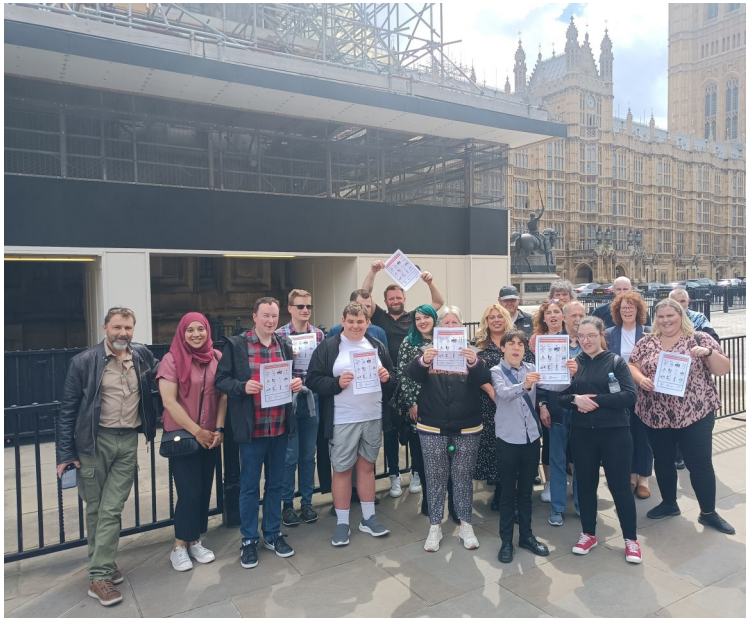
It was great to see some of the famous sights in London!

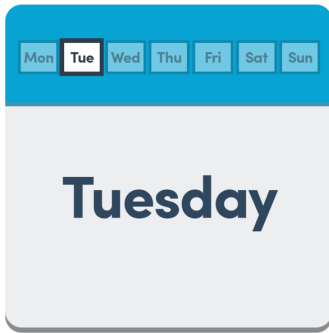
