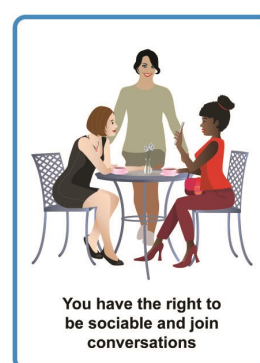
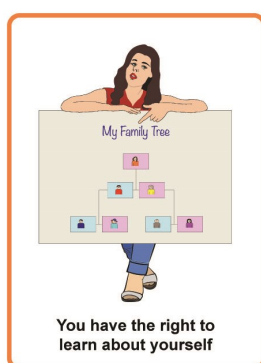
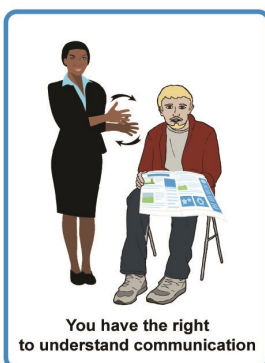
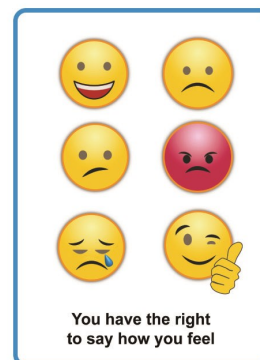
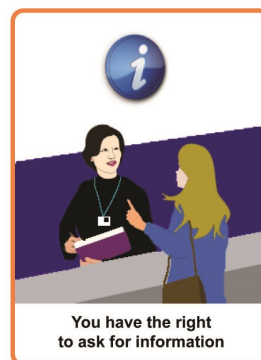
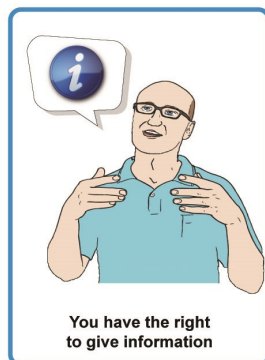


Communication Rights Charter

We want people to understand we have the RIGHT to communicate.



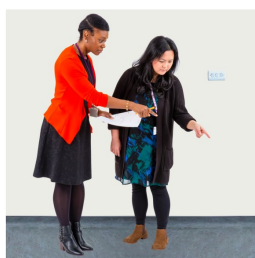
We want emergency services to be trained so they can communicate effectively in matters of life and death
