

CONSULTATION TO REDUCE THE PUBLISHED ADMISSION NUMBER AT RADCLIFFE PRIMARY SCHOOL.

The Keep Learning Trust is consulting on proposals to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN) for Radcliffe Primary School with effect from 1 September 2027. Please share this information with any parents, carers, and external stakeholders who may be interested in the proposed changes. The consultation period will run from 13th October 2025 to 1st December 2025. Any comments received during this period will be considered the Trust.

Consultation on a Proposed Reduction in PAN for Radcliffe Primary School (Effective September 2027)

In accordance with the Schools Admissions Code 2021, all Admission Authorities must undertake statutory consultation when proposing a reduction to a school's PAN. This ensures transparency and allows stakeholders to make representations that will be considered in the decision-making process.

The current PAN for Radcliffe Primary School is 50. The Trust proposes to reduce this to 30 for Reception Year from September 2027 onwards. This means that the number of places available for children in Reception from 2027 and in subsequent years will be 30.

Reducing the PAN will support the school's long-term planning, ensure sustainable staffing and resources, and help maintain high-quality educational outcomes.

Oversubscription Criteria (No Change Proposed)

- Children in public care (Looked After Children) and previously looked after children.
- Children with an older sibling attending the school (including stepsiblings living at the same address).
- Other children, based on proximity to the school (straight-line distance from home to school).

In cases of oversubscription within a category, places will be allocated using Bury Council's computerised mapping system. If two or more children live equidistant from the school, random allocation will be used.
