



FREE DATA CALLS & TEXT SIMS

Did you know you might be eligible for a FREE data loaded SIM card (with calls and texts)?

The criteria for residents eligible for the National and GM Data SIMs are:

- To be at least 18 years old
- Come from a low-income household
- Have no or limited access to the internet at home or away from home
- Be unable to afford a monthly contract or top up
- Only one SIM can be supplied per person

The SIMs are for 6 months to 1 year with 24 to 40 GB of data, which depends on the network provider. The available network providers are O2, Vodafone and Three.

The Tech and Café Drop-Ins offer free digital skills support in community spaces where residents feel comfortable. These informal sessions, led by our Digital Buddy volunteers provide 1:1 help without the need for appointments. Held once or twice a week for a few hours, the workshops are flexible and accessible to all.

Library Digital Support Drop-Ins

Across four of our libraries including Bury, Radcliffe, Prestwich and Ramsbottom we host free Digital Buddy 1:1 drop-in sessions. The sessions are ideal for those looking to improve their digital skills or seeking personalised assistance with technology related questions.
