## AINSWORTH,

A township in the parish of Middleton, contains 1,309 acres. Its population in 1851 was 1,781; 1861, 1,803; and in 1871, 1,854. The rateable value is £7,932. The Earl of Wilton is the principal owner of the soil, but James Kenyon Esq., and Messrs. Bolton have also estates here. This township gave name to a local family of considerable antiquity. The Abbey of Cockersand possessed land here granted by King John. The village of *Cockey Moor* is in this township; and here *Christ Church* is situated. It dates from 1580, but was re-built in 1832. It contains 580 sittings of which 262 are free. The benefice is a vicarage of the annual value of £200, in the

patronage of the rector of Middleton, and held by the Rev. Robert Macdonnell Evanson, M.A. The Rev. Norris Dredge, B.A., is curate in charge. Service is also held in the National School, Bury New road. The *Unitarian Chapel*, Cockey Moor, is a picturesque looking building, erected in 1715. It was enlarged in 1773, and considerably repaired in 1845. Rev. Ephraim Turland, minister. Here is also a *Methodist New Connexion Chapel*.

## TOTTINGTON

Is a large village, two and a half miles N.W. from Bury, but the township of Tottington extends five miles from that town, and comprises most of Ramsbottom and the village of Holcombe. In the 17th century the township was divided for local purposes into the two townships of Tottington Higher End and Tottington Lower End, and the latter is still further divided for rating purposes into two divisions. The copyhold manor, originally an appendage to the Crown, was in the successive possession of the Houses of Lincoln and Lancaster, and the seat of the superior court to which the manor of Bury, Middleton, Chatterton, and Alkrington owed suit and service. It was given, with other manors, by Charles II to General Monk, Duke of Albemarle, as a portion of his reward for services to the House of Stuart. The Albemarle possessions were vested in Lady Montague, and from her the manor has descended to the present Duke of Buccleuch. The township contains 5,271 acres, and its rateable value amounts to £53,644. Its population in 1851 was 10,691; 1861, 11,764; and in 1874, 12,531.

The *Church*, dedicated to St. Anne, was erected in 1799, and repaired in 1844, and in 1867 the church was resealed. Several other internal improvements have since been effected. It contains 700 sittings, all of which are free. The benefice is a vicarage, of the annual value of £200, in the patronage of the rector of Bury, and held by the Rev. Samuel Gideon Frederick Perry, M.A. The population of the parish in 1871 was 5,346. *St. John's* (Free Church of England) is a neat stone building, erected in 1867, at a cost of £1,500. It will seat 400 persons. The Rev. John Brunskill, incumbent. The *Congregational Chapel*, Green Mount, is a handsome Gothic edifice with a lofty spire. It was built in 1866-7, at a cost of £3,330. The old chapel is now used for school purposes. The *Wesleyans* have a large chapel here, also a good school erected some years ago, at a cost of £2,000, raised by subscription. *Holly Mount College*, built a few years since by Messrs. Hudson and Hainsworth as an academy for young gentlemen, is a large and pleasantly situated building in a healthy locality, and the instruction imparted is both varied, solid, and extensive. Here is an endowed school, and a Mutual Improvement Society which dates from 1850. The school possesses a considerable endowment. A fair is held on the third Friday in August.

## RADCLIFFE.

This town is situate on the Irwell, and is a station on the East Lancashire line of railway, two and a half miles S.S.W. from Bury, and seven miles N.N.W. from Manchester. It is progressing rapidly, and bids fair, owing in some measure to the great variety of trades carried on, to become a town of considerable importance. The manufacturing of cotton goods, including checks, gingham, fustians, smallwares, &c., is largely carried on. But along with this, which may be considered the staple trade, are extensive chemical works, bleach, dye, and print works, employing a great number of people. Coal is found abundantly in the immediate neighbourhood, and here are also iron foundries, breweries, and various other important trades. The population in 1851 was 6,293; 1861, 8,838; and in 1871, 11,446. It contains 2,533 acres, and its rateable value amounts to £61,172.

Radcliffe is said to have taken its name from a cliffe or rock of the red sandstone formation, on the south side of the Irwell, below its confluence with the Roach. Radcliffe Tower, long since in ruins, was formerly the seat of the Radcliffe family, and it is said to have been one of the most considerable manorial residences in the county. The ancient wooden hall, with massive oak uprights and beams, is supposed to have been erected about the time of Henry IV., and it appears that Richard Radcliffe, high sheriff of Lancashire (32 Edward III.), was of Radcliffe Tower. An alabaster slab in the church, of the same antiquity, covered the remains of James de Radcliffe, the founder of the mansion. To this place and family are attached the legend and ballad in Percy's Reliques. The Park attached to the Tower stretched for some distance along the vale of the Irwell. Radcliffe is separated from the township of Pilkington by the river Irwell, which is here crossed by a bridge of two arches. The new line of railway connecting Manchester with Prestwich, Whitefield, and the adjacent townships, has a station here. By the opening of this line, a considerable boon has been conferred on the inhabitants of these towns, as there is now direct access to Bolton and surrounding districts, this line being joined to the Bury and Bolton branch a short distance from Bradley Fold.

The local government of the town is vested in the hands of a *Local Board*, consisting of twelve members, whose office is in Water Street, and the town is lighted with gas by the *Radcliffe and Pilkington Gas Co., Limited*, who have large works in Irwell Street. The adjoining district of Whitefield is also supplied with gas from these works. There is also a plentiful supply of water, and the office of the *Water Works Company* is situated in Blackburn Street.

The *Parish Church*, dedicated to St. Bartholomew, is an ancient structure, with a low square tower. It was in existence in 1282, and the architecture is of various styles. It was restored, and a new transept added in 1846. The church contains 568 sittings, of which 520 are free. The benefice is a rectory, of the annual value of £475, in the patronage of the Earl of Wilton, and held by the Rev. Henry Arthur Starkie, M.A. The population of the parish, in 1871, was 5,429. *St. Thomas's Church*, Blackburn Street, is a large and substantial stone edifice, erected in 1819. It was rebuilt in 1864, from a design by Mr. W. Walker, at a cost of £7,300. It contains 1,210 sittings, of which 512 are free. The benefice is a vicarage, of the annual value of £300, in the patronage of the Earl of Wilton, and held by the Rev. Robert Fletcher, M.A. (surrogate.) Population of the parish, 6,017. *St. Andrew's Church*, Black Lane, is a handsome Gothic edifice, erected in 1877, at a cost of £5,500, raised by subscription. The design was supplied by Mr. J. Lowe, and the site presented by the Earl of Wilton. It contains 474 sittings, all free. The benefice is a vicarage, of the annual value of £235, in the patronage of the rector of Radcliffe, and held by the Rev. Samuel Williamson. Population of the parish, 2,500. *St. John the Evangelist's Church*, Stand Lane, is a neat building, erected in 1866, at a cost of £3,790. It is from a design by Mr. J. M. Taylor, and contains 785 sittings, of which 409 are free. The benefice is a vicarage, of the annual value of £240, in the patronage of three Trustees, and held by the Rev. William David Carter, M.A. Population of the parish, 3,883. The *Catholic Chapel*, dedicated to St. Mary, is situated in Victoria Street. It dates from 1863, but in 1878 a new and more commodious building was erected, at a cost of £2,000. Rev. John C. Mussely, priest. The Catholic population is 1,144. The *New Jerusalem Church*, Stand Lane, was erected in 1879. It occupies the site of two previous chapels, one being built in 1803 and the other in 1841. The design was supplied by Mr. Thomas Thorpe, and the style of architecture is Free Classic. The church is of stone externally, with dressings from the Slaithwaite quarries. Two turrets, 60 feet high, ornament the church in front. The total length of the building is 74 feet, and its width is 45 feet. The internal accommodation comprises nave and aisles, and galleries on the south, west, and north sides, and organ chamber and vestries at the east end. The church seats 650 persons, and the cost of its erection was £3,500. Rev. John Boys, minister. The other chapels, belonging to the

Nonconformists, are the *Wesleyan Chapels* at Radcliffe Hall, Radcliffe Bridge, and Stand Lane ; the *Primitive Methodist Chapels* in Blackburn Street and Railway Street ; and the *Independent Chapels*, Water Street and Church Street. There are in the town Conservative and Liberal Clubs, Working Men's Clubs, a Temperance Society, &c. A Public Hall for meetings, &c., is in Sion Street, and in Railway Street is the Police Station. Races were at one time held here, but they have been discontinued for some time. Fairs are held on April 28th and September 28th.
