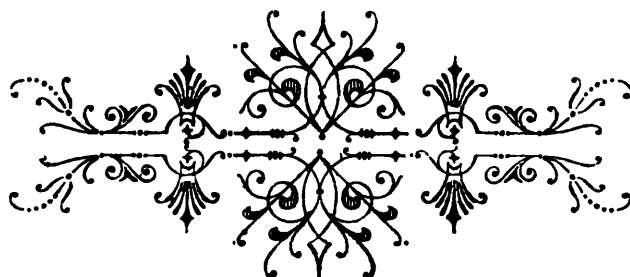

RADCLIFFE AND PILKINGTON.

RADCLIFFE is a parish in the hundred of Salford, diocese of Manchester, and is the head of the recently constituted Parliamentary division of Radcliffe-cum-Farnworth, which comprises the townships of Radcliffe, Pilkington, Farnworth, Kearsley, and Little Hulton. The gentleman returned in December, 1885, and again in July, 1886, was Robert Leake, Esq., who represented South-East Lancashire, of which constituency Radcliffe formed a portion. This place dates from the time of the Saxon monarchy, and the name is said to be derived from the red cliffs of the sandstone formation, which appear in some parts of the precipitous banks of the river. The parish lies along the right or northern bank of the Irwell, and contains several hamlets, the principal place, which is joined to Pilkington by an ancient bridge, being about 6 miles N.N.W. from Manchester, 2½ (by rail) S.S.W. from Bury, situated close to the Lancashire and Yorkshire railway; and the Bolton and Bury canal passes through the parish. The bridge has been widened by an addition on one side. The population of this parish is almost exclusively dependent upon the numerous manufactures established within it. These consist chiefly of calicoes, ginghams, checks, drills, nankeens, ticks, smallwares, cotton spinning, bleach and dye works, print works, chemical manufactories, paper works, &c. Coal mines are also worked in the parish and its vicinity. The town and district are supplied with gas. The Radcliffe and Pilkington Co-operative Industrial Society, Limited, whose premises are situated in Stand lane, is a very imposing and commodious building, consisting of shops, offices, library, reading room and hall. The number of books in the library, including those in the reference library, now reaches about 4,000 volumes. The dimensions of the hall are 111 ft. by 43 ft. 6 in., and it is capable of accommodating from 1,200 to 1,300 persons. The only objects of antiquarian interest are the parish church, dedicated to St. Bartholomew, a small but ancient edifice, enlarged in 1846, having the interior in the Norman style of architecture; and the ruins of the Tower, formerly the residence of the powerful family of the Radclyffes. The living of Radcliffe is a rectory, annual value £876, in the patronage of the Earl of Wilton. The other places of worship are the churches of St. Thomas, erected in 1819, and rebuilt in 1864, the living of which is a vicarage, yearly value £390, also in the gift of the above nobleman; and St. John's and St. Andrew's, both edifices of more recent erection. The living of the first-named is a vicarage, of the annual value of £240, in the patronage of three trustees; whilst that of the latter, also a vicarage, is of the yearly value of £250, to which the rector of Radcliffe presents. There are two chapels for Wesleyan Methodists, and one each for Independents, New Connexion Methodists, and Roman Catholics. A market was built in 1852 by the then Earl of Wilton, which cost nearly £1,500. The parish comprises 2,466 acres, and its population was in 1871, 11,446, and in 1881, 16,263.

PILKINGTON, in the parish of Prestwich, is a populous township, six miles N.W. from Manchester. It includes a considerable village, joined to Radcliffe by a bridge over the Irwell, together passing under the name of **RADCLIFFE BRIDGE**, and, like other villages in this part of Lancashire, has a population dependent chiefly upon the cotton manufacture. The township comprises 5,378 acres. Population in 1871, 11,949, and in 1881, 13,125.
