# RAMSBOTTOM,

CHATTERTON, EDENFIELD, HAWKSHAW LANE, HOLCOMBE, HOLCOMBE BROOK, ROSE BANK, SHUTTLEWORTH, STUBBINS, AND SUMMERSEAT.

**R**AMSBOTTOM is a manufacturing town in the chapelry of Holcombe, township of Tottington Lower End, parish of Bury, hundred of Salford, diocese of Manchester, and in the Heywood electoral division of South-East Lancashire, 13 miles N. from Manchester, 4 N. from Bury, and the same distance from Rawtenstall, situated on the Lancashire and Yorkshire railway, which has a station here. The father of the late Sir Robert Peel first established calico printing here, and the Messrs. Ashton introduced the cotton trade at the beginning of the present century. The town is governed by a Local Board, formed in 1864, and is well provided with gas and water, the former being supplied by the Ramsbottom Gas Company, and the latter conveyed from works at Bury. A number of cotton factories are in operation in the town and its vicinity, and the works of Messrs. Porritt furnish employment for a great number of operatives, in the manufacturing of woollen, cotton, and linen cloths for machinery. There are also calico printing and bleaching works. The late Mr. Grant erected a church, dedicated to St. Andrew, in connection with the Establishment of Scotland; the first stone was laid in May, 1832, and the edifice was completed in 1834. It is of stone, ornamented with buttresses and a tower of elegant proportions, surmounted by pinnacles; the vicarage adjoining was erected in 1883. This church, which was consecrated in 1875, was licensed by the late Bishop of Manchester, and placed under the Establishment; the living is a vicarage, of the annual value of £233, in the patronage of Mrs. Isabella Lawson. An elegant church of the Establishment, dedicated to St. Paul, was consecrated in 1850; it was built partly by subscription and by the Messrs. Ashton, who in addition gave the ground for the site. It is in the early English style of architecture, the total cost being about £3,500. In 1866 it was enlarged at a further expenditure of £1,000. The living is a vicarage, of the annual value of £300, in the gift of the Crown and the Bishop of Manchester alternately. There are places of worship for Independents, Baptists, Swedenborgians, Wesleyans, Primitive and United Free Methodists, Scotch Presbyterians, and Roman Catholics. At HAZLEHURST, about one mile from the town, is a cemetery, which was opened in 1875; it contains eight acres of land, and there is a division each for the Church of England, the Nonconformists, and the Roman Catholics. Fairs are held on April 28th, and the first Monday after the 27th of August. The population of Ramsbottom is returned with that of Tottington Lower End.

HOLCOMBE, or HOLCOMBE BROOK, is a chapelry in the township of Tottington Lower End, three-quarters of a mile S. from Ramsbottom. The inhabitants are nearly all occupied in the manufacturing establishments. The church, which existed in 1660, and was dedicated to Emanuel, was taken down and another built on its site in 1853, by subscription and a grant from the Church Building Society. The

benefice is a rectory, of the annual value of £185, in the gift of the rector of Bury. The village stands on an eminence, and there was erected in 1852, on the summit of Holcombe Moor a handsome square tower of stone, 120 feet high, to the memory of the late Sir Robert Peel, from the top of which an extensive view of the surrounding neighbourhood may be enjoyed. There is a station here on the Lancashire and Yorkshire branch line from Bury to Holcombe Brook. Population returned with Tottington Lower End.

CHATTERTON, ROSE BANK and STUBBINS are villages or hamlets in the township of Tottington Higher End, parish of Bury. At Stubbins is a fine Congregational church, in the perpendicular style of architecture; it is built of white freestone, presented by the Messrs. Porritt, of Stubbins Vale, and was opened in 1867. Population in 1871, 3,595, and in 1881, 3,926.

SHUTTLEWORTH is a village and chapelry formed from the ancient parish of Bury, 5 miles N. from that town, and 4 S.E. from Haslingden. It is a locality of some consequence in the manufacturing district, there being several cotton factories and a paper mill. There are also extensive stone quarries. The church, dedicated to St. John in the Wilderness, was consecrated in 1848; the living, a vicarage, of the annual value of £160, is in the gift of the Crown and Bishop alternately. There is a National school in connection with the church, also a Board school at TURN, a small hamlet about a mile from the village.

EDENFIELD is an ancient parochial chapelry and village, in the township of Tottington Higher End, and parish of Bury. The village is 5 miles N. from that town, about 3 S.S.E. from Haslingden, and about 2 from Ramsbottom, situated in a populous district on the road from Burnley to Bury. The prosperity of Edenfield may be wholly ascribed to the manufacturing establishments, which, in common with many other districts, have called this place into notice. The manufacture of cotton goods now flourishes in the village and its vicinage. The church, which dates from 1614, was rebuilt in 1778, and in connection with it are day and Sunday schools. The living is a perpetual curacy, of the annual value of £300, in the gift of the rector of Bury. The Primitive and Wesleyan Methodists have places of worship here. The population is returned with the township.

SUMMERSEAT is a small village 3 miles from Bury, and a mile and a half from Ramsbottom, and is a station on the Lancashire and Yorkshire railway. It is situated in the three townships of Tottington Lower End, Walmsley-cum-Shuttleworth, and Elton. The inhabitants are chiefly employed in the cotton mills of the district. In the village are a small Mechanics' Institute and Reading Room, and a Wesleyan Methodist chapel, with day and Sunday schools in connection.
