Our Primary Education Programme, led by Dr. Rebecca Baxter of Down Syndrome UK, supports primary schools working with pupils with Down syndrome.

- **Support**: Regular online sessions with experts highly experienced in working with children with Down syndrome, and the opportunity to meet and share ideas with other schools.
- Training: An accredited online course covering the learning strengths of pupils with Down syndrome, strategies to promote inclusive practices, and guidance around differentiating the curriculum. The course is designed for SENCOs, teachers and teaching assistants and focuses on evidence-based guidance and education in schools.
- Information: Access to practical information sessions and videos covering a range of education and health needs including developing literacy and numeracy, supporting hearing and vision difficulties, as well as supporting friendships and positive behaviour.
- Resources: We are extending our current resources for schools to include practical activities and examples to support learning across the curriculum as well as tools to target and measure individual progress.

As an introductory offer, the programme is available for £100 for the first 100 schools that sign up, (additional children charged at £75 each.)
