



## Progress update: 13<sup>th</sup> March 2024

We'd like to provide a short update on the engineering works at Pilsworth South Landfill.

Three, 25 metre deep wells are now connected and extracting landfill gas from the newly temporarily capped area. A further 25m depth well is being connected today and the 5<sup>th</sup> and potentially 6<sup>th</sup> well will be drilled and connected by the end of the day tomorrow (14<sup>th</sup> March 2024).



We will continue to drill and connect the additional wells as quickly and as safely as possible over the coming week.

The continued wet weather has slowed the progress of the capping work, but we are continuing to work dynamically to deliver these engineering solutions. We will keep you informed of progress throughout as we have been doing.

Weather permitting, we anticipate that the drilling and connection of the remaining gas extraction wells will be completed within the next 7 days. These are labour intensive and complex works.

As previously stated, the site will remain closed to waste inputs until this work is completed, however we will continue to accept restoration material used to cover and stabilise the capping material.

We apologise for any odour issues during this time, we remain fully committed to completing these engineering works quickly and effectively.
