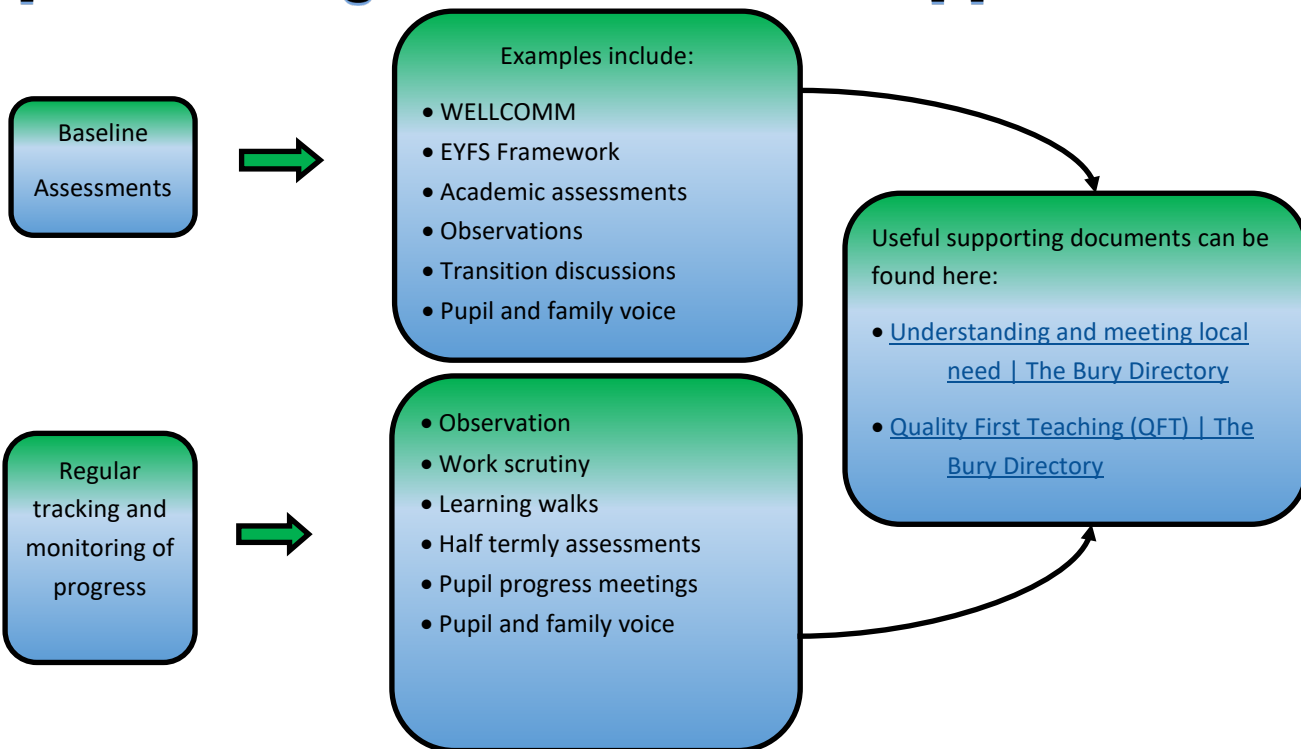


Implementing the Graduated Approach

Pre-Graduated Approach

Any change in pupil presentation or progress, **Notice/Check/Try** process should be considered



NCT process

The Notice, Check, Try model aims to support class teachers with the early identification of needs and early intervention. This model is helpful at the earliest stage when concerns first arise and before it is possible to determine whether a child or young person may have a special educational need. This model could be used for up to the first 2 terms of any period of concern, with a flexible approach according to the level of need.

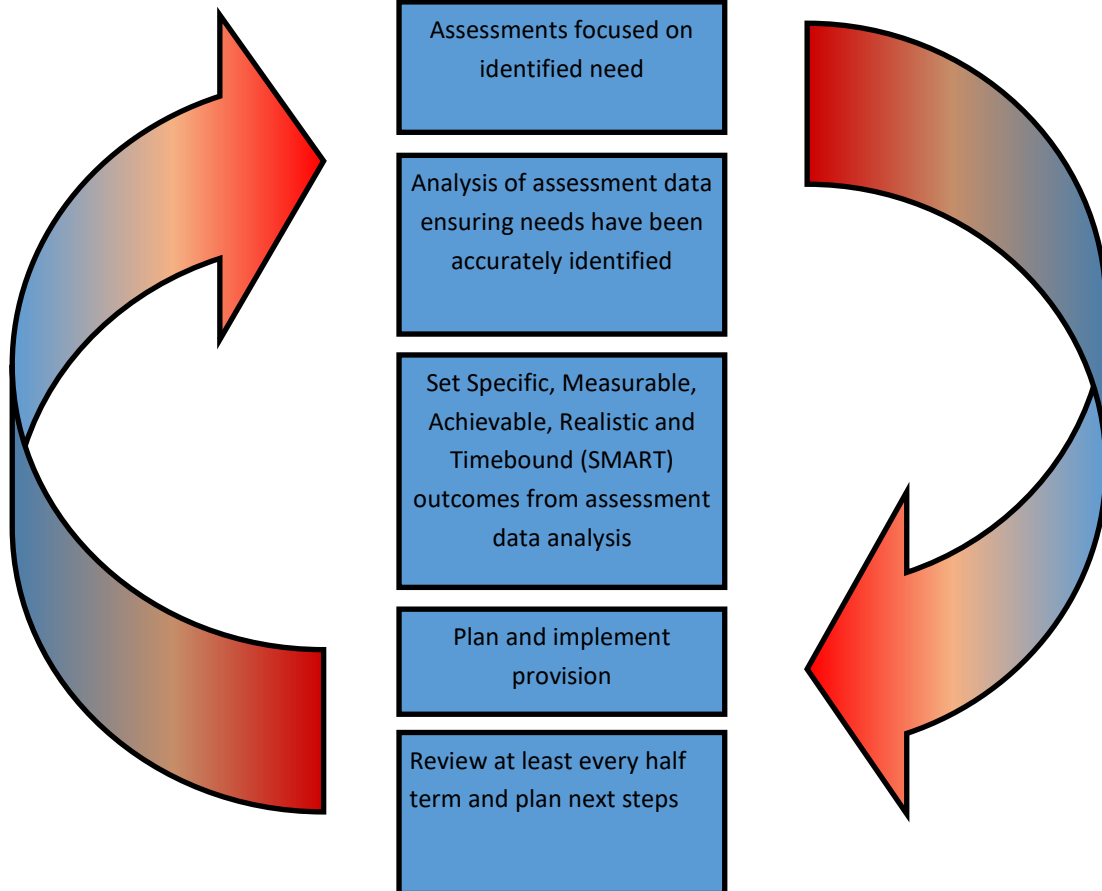
Early advice from services may be considered:

- Speech and Language Therapy Service
- Early Help Locality Team
- School Nursing Service
- First Point Family Support Service (referral via CAMHS/Social Care/School Nursing)
- Multi Agency Safeguarding Hub
- Mental Health Support Team



If adjustments are not having sufficient impact, consider adding the pupil to the SEN list and implementing cycles of Assess Plan Do Review (APDR)
