Footpath	Prestwich		1	8	64	Bury Old Road to Nursery Road. Posts across end of footway between houses and Welcome Inn on Bury Old Road. Footway rough surface unfenced on either side.
Footpath	Prestwich		2	8	32	Elm Grove to Guest Road. Walled and fenced both sides. Rough ash surface. Electric Lamp on bend of footway.
Footpath	Prestwich		4	8	48	Heywood Road near Orange Hill railway bridge to Rectory Lane . Open entry to footway between 83 and 85 Heywood Road. Footway fenced both sides. Open to Park Avenue and to Rectory Lane . Surface of footway ashed.
Footpath	Prestwich		5	8	64	Whittaker Lane to Earl Street. Footway fenced both sides. Surface macadam. Two stumps both ends with notice.
Footpath	Prestwich		6	8	113	Thorndyke Walk. Bury New Road opp. Butterstile Lane to Heywood Road. Two steps up from Bury New Road. Steep part of footway paved. Sett grips across cindered footway. Fenced both sides . Electric lamp opposite houses. 7 steps down to Heywood Road.
Footpath	Prestwich		7	8	48	Sedgley Park Road to Parksway. Common entry from Sedgley Park Road. Fenced across footway, opening through. Notice 'private road. Persons using this footway do so at their own risk'. Footway fenced both sides, tress growing in footway. Fenced, opening and notice at Parksway end.
Footpath	Prestwich		9	8	386	From footpath No.10 by Roll Row Cottages to George Street.
Footpath	Prestwich		10	8	547	Hilton Lane opposite Long Knowle past Roll Row Cottages to Kersal Moor and Moor Lane in city of Salford. Gate across road with open style at Hilton Lane end. Painted on gate "Heathlands" Private Road". Footway leads in private drive to "Heathlands". Sandy rough surface, condition of footway near cottages dangerous. Kersal Moor end of footway open.
Footpath	Prestwich		11	8	193	Extension of Chapel Road, Rainsough, to boundary of district by Cussons works. Iron post centre of footway off road to Hollywell House. Fenced both sides. Rough surface. Iron posts centre of footway half way down the footway to Cussons works. Paving commences. Footway turns in to Moor Lane, Salford. Line of footway appears to have been altered at side of works.
Footpath	Prestwich		12	8	306	Open end from footway to Drinkwater Park. Rough sandy surface . Steps up into

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Footpath	Prestwich		13	8	1355	Butterstile Lane. From Rainsough Brow opposite Kersal Vale through Drinkwater Park. Gate across road, small gate opens. Cross two footbridges past councils sewage works to Buckley Lane (Wash Lane).

Footpath	Prestwich		15	7&8	1906	From Bury New Road. Open entry adjacent to St. Mary's Park. Through Prestwich clough. Footway splits and joins up again at footbridge in clough. Open entry from Wash Lane past clough bleach works. Past councils sewage works, past Waterdale Dyeworks to boundary of district.
Footpath	Prestwich		16	8	241	From Ramsbottom Row to footpath through clough. Footpath slightly diverted at entrance to fields from Arthur Street, by builders operations. Open down to junction with footpath in Prestwich clough.
Footpath	Prestwich		17	8	161	From Clough Lane to footway through Prestwich clough. Also steps up side of embankment into Clough Walks.
Footpath	Prestwich		18	8	64	From footpath through Prestwich clough along back of houses fronting Ruskin Road.
Footpath	Prestwich		19	8	64	From footpath through Prestwich clough to Ruskin Road.
Footpath	Prestwich		20	8	306	From St. Ann's Road, opp. Lowther Road. Gate stumps off St. Ann's Road. Right angles. Across clough steps up from clough. Stump centre of footway. Footway here is paved to Church. Open entrance to Church Lane.
Footpath	Prestwich		21	8	113	From footpath 15 (connection with Bury New Road) to footpath 20 to Church Lane.
Footpath	Prestwich		22	8	225	Gateway to path from Gardner Road to War Memorial. Footway deviated to right of fence, down fence and between allotments to higher footpath through clough (footpath 15). Stops at clough end of footway. Footway fenced both sides through allotments.
Footpath	Prestwich		23	8	225	Gateway from Gardner Road. Towards War Memorial. Footway deviates to left of fence across open field track to footway No.15 through Prestwich clough.
Footpath	Prestwich		24	7&8	1810	From Bury New Road by Brook cottage past back of county mental hospital to Mere Clough down Mere Clough to waterdale dyeworks and then to Clifton Road. This footpath in places runs into the adjoining district of Whitefield as F.P. No.33.

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Footpath	Prestwich		25	8	354	From footpath No.24 in Mere Clough across footbridge through opening in wrought iron fencing. Footway fenced both sides and part of footway brick paved. Footway widens out, ashed and lit by electric lights on hospital wall. Open to Clifton Road.
Bridleway	Prestwich		27a	6	1480	Bridle road off Simister Lane along northern side of Heaton Park Reservoir, metalled and kerbed, fenced both sides along length of reservoir. Continues alongside motorway following the county boundary until it closes a footbridge over the motorway and finishes at Old Hall Lane.
Bridleway	Prestwich		27b	6	32	From Old Hall Lane to the motorway.
Bridleway	Prestwich		28a	6	272	From bridleway 27 to the motorway where it links with FP No.29.
Footpath	Prestwich		28b	6	384	Starts at Simister Lane, runs to motorway and then joins F.P. No.29.
Footpath	Prestwich		29a	6	120	From bridleway 27 to the motorway.
Footpath	Prestwich		29b	6	896	From Simister Lane to Mellowdew Farm. Open stile to field path . Open branch on right to Simister opp. "Same Yet". Stiles and gates open to Nut Lane. Cross Nut Lane. Stone stump stile to bridle path . Past Heywood Farm and terminates at motorway.
Footpath	Prestwich		30	6	1265	Open stile from Old Hall Lane by Parkwood cottages. Notice "Trespassers on these lands will be prosecuted. Any persons giving information leading to a conviction will be amply rewarded. Dogs found trespassing will be shot on sight and owners prosecuted. By order." Open stile through hedges. Notice on telegraph pole by reservoir. Open stile through to fence by Bowlee Brow.
Footpath	Prestwich		31	8	113	From the eastern corner of Nos 6 & 12 Tulle Court in a north easterly direction for 15m then north westerly for 22m, terminating at the adopted highway of Tulle Court. The route is 1.8m in width. Diverted 21/12/2007.
Footpath	Prestwich		32	8	32	End of Masefield Avenue. Open both ends. Tarmac surface. "Cycling Prohibited" notices to end of Byron Avenue.
Footpath	Prestwich		33	8	32	Open at St. Ann's Road end where "Cycling Prohibited" notice is displayed. Surface is paved with old Tarmacadam and ashes. Runs into natural footpaths of Prestwich Clough.
Footpath	Prestwich		34	8	64	From Hollyedge Drive to Beckley Avenue. Open both ends. "cycling prohibited" notices. Tarmacadam.

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Footpath	Prestwich		35	8	48	From Polefield Grange up two flights of concrete steps along tarmac path between paling fences down one step into Polefield Hall Road. "cycling prohibited" notices displayed at both ends.
Footpath	Prestwich		36	8	64	From Polefield Road to Daneshill. Ashed surface, open ends. "cycling prohibited" notices displayed at both ends.
Footpath	Prestwich		37	8	64	From Rectory Grove to Park View Road. Open both ends. "cycling prohibited" notices each end.
Footpath	Prestwich		38	8	48	From the Meadows to Green Walks "cycling prohibited" notice at both ends. Tarmacadam surface.
Footpath	Prestwich		39	8	64	Green Walks to Bannerman Avenue. Tarmac surface "cycling prohibited" notice at each end.
Footpath	Prestwich		40	8	80	From Scholes Walk to Bannerman Avenue. "cycling prohibited" notices at both ends and in middle. Surface tarmacadam.
Footpath	Prestwich		41	8	32	From Noreen Avenue to Hastings Road opposite Orange Hill Road. Open both ends, each having "Cycling Prohibited" notices. Surfaced with ashes and brickbats.
Footpath	Prestwich		42	8	64	From southern end of West Road to Clifton Road. Wooden post west end and down a flight of steps to Clifton Road, surfaces with setts. "cycling prohibited" notices at both ends.
Footpath	Prestwich		43	8	145	An open entry from Scholes Lane through two stone gateposts. No gates being hung. This is the drive to the Town Hall and passes through the grounds terminating on Bannerman Avenue by two flights of stone steps or by branch footpath to the left. Tarmacadam surface.
Footpath	Prestwich		44	8	113	Entry from Gardner Road through stone gateposts. The surface is of tarmacadam and the way terminates in a footpath encircling the War Memorial.
Footpath	Prestwich		45	8	129	An open entry from Simister Lane between cottages. Obstructed by a single strand of barbed wire with a notice "no access to cricket ground". Follows along right of hedge line to gate posts which are closed off by barbed wire. Fence line now on right and path terminates at an old well, now used for watering cattle. Natural and unmetalled surface.
Footpath	Prestwich		46	6	306	From Heywood Old Road through open gate passing to right of hedge line on ashed track. Through gate posts where hedge line is on right and across a bridged ditch,

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no handrail, to footpath No.30.

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Footpath	Prestwich		47	8	894	All Footpaths within Prestwich clough. A network of natural footpaths linking all accesses to the park. Parts extinguished 08/07/2009.
Footpath	Prestwich		49	8	241	From junction with FP No.10 at the houses at Role Row, across field 589 to Heathlands Drive at the entrance to Heathlands House.
Footpath	Prestwich		50	6	402	Simister Lane to Lower Droughts Farm to link with FP No.46 at Whitefield urban district boundary.
Footpath	Prestwich		51	8	149	Starts between 5 and 7 Hilton Drive where it is 1.5m wide with an unmade surface, heading east north east for 23m, it then turns east south easterly for 24m. At 34m surface becomes bitmac 1.5m wide. Turn east north easterly for 20m then north east for 82m at 82 m from start the surface becomes concrete slabs 3m wide.
Footpath	Prestwich		52	8	24	From Footpath No.16, Prestwich at the rear of No.1 Carmona Drive, in a southerly direction for 46m then easterly for 22m to join the access road to Tulle Court. Whole path is 68m in length and is 1.8m in width.
Footpath	Prestwich		53	8	25	The path leaves public footpath number 19, Prestwich, 28 metres from the junction with Ruskin Road. It travels in a northerly direction ending at its junction with public footpath number 47, Prestwich. The path is unsurfaced, 1.2 metres in width and is 25 metres in length.
Footpath	Prestwich		54	8	4	The path leaves public footpath number 47, Prestwich at the rear of house number 126 St Anns Road, running in a north westerly direction to join another section of public footpath number 47, Prestwich. The path is unsurfaced 1.2 metres in width and is 4 metres in length.
