It runs in an easterly direction for 102m along a path surfaced with pre-cast concrete flags, running between the gardens of the properties on Osborne Walk and a fence marking the boundary of the allotments. This section of path is between 1.7m and 1.85m in width. The path splits into two. A 6m section runs directly down a grassed embankment in an easterly direction to the edge of Pavilion Walk. This section is 1.7m in width. An 18m section runs in a north easterly direction, diagonally along the embankment to the edge of Pavilion Walk. This path is 1.7m in width. A further section of path leaves this path and travels in an easterly direction along the embankment for 3m to the edge of Pavilion Walk. The path is 1.7m in width. The whole length of path is 129m.
