

Supplementary Planning Document 11 – Parking Standards in Bury

This notice has been prepared in accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that, (in accordance with regulations 11, 12, 14 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 and Section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended), Bury Council has adopted Supplementary Planning Document 11 –Parking Standards in Bury with effect from 11th June 2025.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Supplementary Planning Document 11– Parking Standards in Bury may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a. the document is not within the appropriate power.
- b. a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application to the High Court must be made before the end of the period of three months beginning with the day after the relevant date, which is the day after the adoption of Supplementary Planning Document 11 –Parking Standards in Bury takes effect, (i.e. from 12th June 2025 to no later than 12th September 2025).

In relation to Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and Regulation 11(2)(b) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, some minor modifications have been made to the Supplementary Planning Document following consultation on the draft document.

In accordance with regulations 11, 12, 14 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, as soon as practicable after the date of adoption (11th June 2025), the following documents will be made available for inspection via the council's website at www.bury.gov.uk/spd:
